Facilitator Information Sheet

This resource was created by the Trinity College Dublin team (Nicole Maiorano, Pia Gardeweg and Katie Moore) for use in the Irish REFUGE-ED pilot site. It was used in the Irish pilot site with a group of approximately 40 children. The information below is a facilitator information sheet with sample activities. It is designed to be used as part of an Interactive Group exercise. The intended audience is children approximately 7 to 8 years old of all migration backgrounds.

Description of activity:

Draw what is written on the card for other students to guess.

Learning objectives:

Strand: Oral language

Communicating: Listening and attention

Understanding: Vocabulary; demonstration of understanding

Exploring and using: Description

Materials needed:

Pencil

Paper for drawing

Category decks of items to be drawn

Instructions:

1. Select the category deck to be used for today's interactive groups
2. Child picks an item from the category
3. That child draws the item on a piece of paper
4. All other children in the group guess what is being drawn
5. When it has been guessed, the next child picks an item, and then it is their turn to draw
